We will use this space to provide the Nashville #49 community with updates on COVID-19 data and for making parental notifications regarding new cases. Please know that we are in regular communication with the Washington County Health Department and use their guidance to help us make decisions. As a reminder, the Illinois Department of Public Health defines “close contact” as someone who is within 3 feet of you for 15 cumulative minutes. This threshold will always be used when the school district conducts contact tracing after the confirmation of a positive case. This page will be updated regularly as data changes or when additional notifications are needed. Here is the data that pertains to individuals affiliated with Nashville #49:
