

**NASHVILLE COMMUNITY CONSOLIDATED SCHOOL DISTRICT #49
BACK TO SCHOOL PLAN FOR 2021-2022**

It is the overall goal of Nashville #49 to make the 2021-2022 school year as normal as possible

All classes will again be in session for 5 days per week with a start time of 8:25 AM and a dismissal time of 3:00 PM. Normal schedules and activities will resume immediately.

The district will be prepared to adjust educational and athletic programming as necessary throughout the year.

The district will not require a proof of vaccination card from any student, staff member, or visitor.

The State of Illinois has imposed a mask mandate on K-12 schools. Everyone (regardless of vaccination status) must wear a mask while inside a school building.

In accordance with the CDC mandate, Nashville #49 will require all passengers and drivers to wear a mask while on school buses.

Remote learning will only be available if a student is under quarantine and has not yet received a vaccination. Our district will require a medical certification from families that request remote learning for medical reasons.

Temperature checks and symptom screenings will be discontinued. Parents should keep their children home from school when they are sick.

Good hand hygiene will be strongly encouraged at all grade levels.

Social distancing will be maintained to the greatest extent possible.

All student meals (breakfast and lunch) will again be free for the 2021-2022 school year.

We anticipate all athletic events to run as normal this year. This will include regular spectator attendance, admissions, concessions, etc.

Field trips and fundraisers will resume as normal.

The use of volunteers will not begin at the start of the year. Unless otherwise noted, volunteers can be used in the school beginning on Tuesday, September 7.
